

1. The subject for the 2018 Suffolk Beauty Photographic Competition is '**Beautiful Modern Buildings**'. This should be a photograph of a single or group of modern buildings which you really like and which exhibits good design. This could be anything from a small extension to a housing estate or even a public building. Modern is loosely defined as post-1945.
2. Buildings can be located within Suffolk or beyond its boundaries.
3. Entrants can submit **up to four photos**
4. Entrants must not be professional photographers and, for the purposes of this competition, a professional photographer will be considered to be someone who makes more than half their annual income from the sale of their photographs.
5. The competition closes at **midnight on 28 February 2019**
6. All entries will be judged by a panel who will consider a range of factors including composition, originality and interpretation of the brief.
7. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party.
8. Prior to submission, entrants must not have offered any of their entries for sale, been paid for any publication of any of their entries or won or been a runner up in any other photographic competition with any of their entries.
9. Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit. By entering the competition all entrants grant to the Suffolk Preservation Society the right to publish and exhibit their photographs in print, on the SPS website or in any other media. While we will make every effort to credit photographers, we cannot guarantee that every use of the photographs will include the photographers' names.
